HR MANAGEMENT ALERT: CURRENT I-9 FORM USE IS EXTENDED



Just a few days before the current Employment Eligibility Verification Form I-9 was set to expire, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services announced an extension of the current form. Employers must complete and retain a Form I-9 for all newly-hired employees to verify their identity and authorization to work in the United States.

Earlier this year USCIS published a notice in the Federal Register informing the public of the proposed extension of the form. Until a new version is released, the current Form I-9 which contains the expiration date of 8/31/19 should continue to be utilized for employment verification purposes.
